1. Exeter Town Hall

Iconic building centered in historic Exeter's vibrant downtown with a well lit 2nd floor gallery space. Current Seacoast Artist Association annual show, "Primavera: The Art of Spring" to benefit the SAA scholarship fund for area students pursuing secondary art education. Elevator (slow!) access in rear.

2. Seacoast Artist Association *

Nonprofit group of over 200 area artists with a sensational gallery space offering a variety of affordable local art in central downtown Exeter. See the current monthly theme show: "In Plein Site." On the 2nd Friday of each month enjoy new art theme show receptions with live music and refreshments. Also take advantage of our "2nd Sunday" program of artist demos and presentations (11:30AM-1:00PM)

3. Exeter Fine Crafts

An elegant, inspiring non-profit gallery and teaching facility. Founded in 1966, we represent over 200 local artists and craftspeople. EFC continues the tradition of featuring the highest quality local art, pottery, jewelry, glass, wood, fiber and more. It is the largest selection of juried original handcrafts on the Seacoast.

4. A Picture's Worth

Lively mix of New England artists, fine art books, prints, antique maps, and framing.

5. Windows on Water *

Discover a unique vignette style gallery one flight down from Water Street Marketplace overlooking the river at String Bridge featuring local artists offering a variety of contemporary oils and watercolor paintings along with fine crafts, pottery and Shaker boxes too!

6. Foundation Art Space *

A small mixed-use gallery, studio and performance venue located on the backside of downtown along the river. It is headquarters for TEAM, a nonprofit organization hosting regular member and guest art shows, musical performances, poetry readings and workshops. www.TeamExeter.com

7. Art by Allysa

An independent artist owned shop featuring her original paintings and a host of affordable gift products imprinted with her fun colorful images.

8. Diane Crespo Fine Art *

Artist studio. Stunning landscape and seascape paintings in oil or soft pastels. Custom pet portraits.

9. Art Up Front Street

Beautiful contemporary gallery with five working studios. Large colorful abstract paintings, "industrial quilts", collage and more!


10. Exeter Station Studios *
